FIELD TRIP TO KURUMBAPATTI PARK

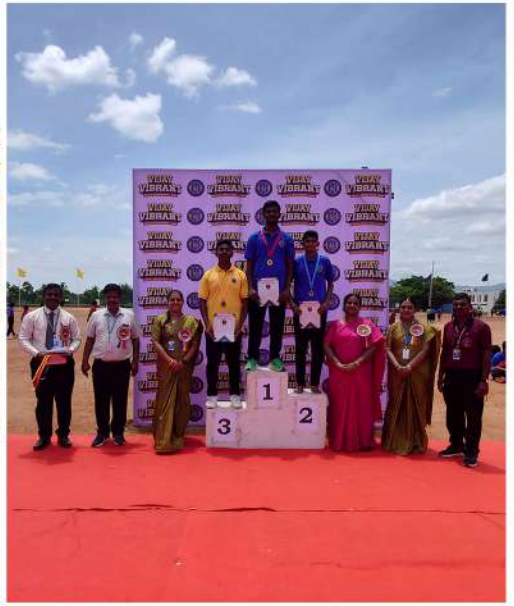
